Please find enclosed a copy of a petition I have received from 218 residents in the Marlpit Hill community in Edenbridge regarding the safety of the road at the junction of B2026 Main Road, Hilders Lane and Hillcrest Road.

While I recognise that it is Kent County Council, as the highways authority, who are responsible for roads in the area, you will note that residents have identified parking on double yellow lines outside The Row on Main Road as one of the factors causing this junction to be especially dangerous. I would appreciate it if you could address whether Sevenoaks District Council would be able to ensure that Civil Enforcement Officers are able to patrol this area more closely to ensure that all cars which are parked on double yellow lines are in receipt of the appropriate tickets.

I would be grateful if you could answer residents' concerns and let me know what steps you are taking to resolve this.

I look forward to hearing back from you, and have copied this letter to the local District Councillors, James Barnett and Stuart McGregor.
